**Dr. Nancy Edwards, RN, PhD**

Dr. Nancy Edwards is a Full Professor in the School of Nursing at the University of Ottawa, with a cross-appointment to the Department of Epidemiology and Community Medicine; Principal Scientist, Institute of Population Health; Senior Scientist, Elisabeth Bruyere Research Institute; and Academic Consultant, City of Ottawa (Public Health Services). Currently, Dr. Edwards is the holder of a CHSRF/CIHR Chair Award in Nursing (2000-2010). The focus of her award is "Multiple Interventions in Community Health Nursing Care". Dr. Edwards' clinical and research interests are in the fields of public and population health. Her work in global health has spanned four continents where she has led both development-oriented and research-focused projects.
