On November 28th and 29th, 2011 the Public Health Association of BC hosted a Conference and AGM at the Executive Airport Plaza Hotel in Richmond, BC. The conference, entitled: 'The Ottawa Charter for Health Promotion - Critical Engagement from a Health Equity Perspective' acknowledged the 25th anniversary of the creation of the Ottawa Charter. Presenters and participants were encouraged to think critically about the Ottawa Charter, reflecting upon the Charter's positive contributions guiding health promotion work, as well as and identifying considerations for future work in the field. Content in the conference was framed around the five key action areas defined by the Ottawa Charter:

- Building healthy public policy
- Creating supportive environments
- Strengthening community action
- Developing personal skills

Health Care System -Health Ministers meet in Victoria, BC to talk about this topic

Premiers arrived in Victoria for several days of meetings that saw them hash over a response to Ottawa's announcement on health-care funding, which has left many Premiers east of Manitoba seething, and the western ones celebrating the prospect of the federal government finally getting out of the way.

B.C. Premier Christy Clark, who has been positive about the federal government's move last month to tie health-care transfers to expansion of the economy after 2017, said Flaherty's decision to deliver the money on a per-capita basis will unfairly penalize B.C. with its aging population.

The premiers and territorial leaders head into meetings that were originally intended to discuss new ways of doing things in the health-care sector.
