- (iv) Work with First Nations leaders, academic institutions and government, on developing policy and program recommendations for First Nations Health Promotion. The (policy) process entails reviewing relevant literature, conducting interviews, collecting and analysing statistical data, and providing advice to the Board and other officials on health promotion.
- (v) Other duties may be required at the discretion of management due to work needs and project deliverables.
