**Uu-a-thluk (NTC Fisheries), is seeking a term (to March 2019), full-time Fisheries Technician to assist Uu-a-thluk Biologists in fisheries management activities. Based out of Port Alberni, the position will have frequent travel to all Nuuchahnulth territories.**

### **Job Overview:**

Activities will include a variety of fisheries management projects and duties, such as fisheries monitoring, monitoring and assessments of salmon, herring, groundfish, shellfish, data processing and writing. Uu-a-thluk staff will provide training and mentoring in relevant job skills.

### **Qualifications:**

- Experience in the fisheries or natural resource management field
- Experience working within your Nuuchahnulth Nations' fisheries program or another Nuuchahnulth Nations' fisheries program
- An understanding of Nuuchahnulth fisheries and culture
- Experience in conducting salmon escapement and herring spawn surveys
- Experience with shellfish surveys and fisheries catch monitoring an asset
- Comfortable working around water, fishers and boats
- Able to meet deadlines and maintain productive working relationships with other staff and fishers
- Demonstrated ability to multi-task
- Good physical fitness
- The ability to work independently and as part of a team
- The ability to travel, frequently overnight, for extended stays
- Effective written and verbal communications skills
- Computer skills such as Microsoft Office (i.e., Word, Excel, PowerPoint) and Internet
- Boat operator experience/certifications and SRT-1 are required for this position
- Relevant post-secondary education and training an asset
- A driver's license and a reliable vehicle are required for this position
- Provide acceptable criminal record check
