### JOB PURPOSE

The community impact and investment team aligns community needs with expertise, resources and partners. During COVID 19, food security issues have become the immediate concern for our communities across the Lower Mainland and Fraser Valley. That is why UWLM is implementing Local Love Food Hubs to address the overwhelming food insecurity needs of our most vulnerable populations across the Region.

This position provides program, operations, communications and administrative support and coordination on food security initiative and projects. This position will play a role in organizing logistics, maintaining resources and supporting communication with stakeholders and will assist the Manager and team in all aspects of the program. This position assists in the coordination, development, implementation and evaluation of program plans. Additionally, the incumbent in this position may travel to various communities to gather and deliver program information and respond to the needs of the various stakeholders and may be asked to be a public face of the program with limited stakeholders in the absence of the Manager.

### SUMMARY OF DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Facilitates and assists with administration of elements in food security programs and associated events
- Project manages logistics of food distribution, food sourcing and other food security related task
- Acts as a leader in food security community development according to the strategies and goals of the UWLM food security initiative
- Works effectively other departments such as Marketing and Communication, Fundraising, etc. on food security and common goals
- Facilitates the relationships between community stakeholders and UWLM’s strategic initiatives
- Travels within the Lower Mainland to assist in a variety of tasks related to deliverables of the program, including the implementation of the programs project plans will be required on a limited basis
- Stewards all aspects of reporting and data entry, manages data collection and ensures reporting is done timely and adequately; responds to inquiries and prepares reports
- Reconciles program and identifies to the Manager potential risks and mitigation strategies
- Acts as the Manager’s delegate at meetings. Will prepare for and present at meetings accordingly
