About the Opportunity

- The **Williams Lake First Nations Wellness Centre (WLFNWC)** is a new primary care centre opening to improve access to culturally safe care for First Nations people and their families.
- The **Licensed Practical Nurse** is part of a collaborative, multi-disciplinary team that provides team based, trauma-informed care by creating a culturally safe environment in order to promote, maintain and/or restore client health, at all stages of life, with stable or predictable states of health.
- This position provides care and service that meets the standards for Licensed Practical Nurses within the BC College of Nurses and Midwives (BCCNM); and works within the scope of practice for Licensed Practical Nurses as determined by relevant legislation.
- Union Code: PIP (Prof Instit of Public Srv Cda); Hours per week: 37.5

About You

- You have a recognized diploma in Practical Nursing;
- Completion of an advanced nursing foot care training program is an asset;
- You have a current practicing registration as a Licensed Practical Nurse with the British Columbia College of Nurses and Midwives (BCCNM);
- You have a current CPR Certification;
- You have a minimum of 2 years of recent experience;
- You have experience delivering health services in a First Nations setting;
- You have strong knowledge of cultural safety, humility and trauma informed approaches to care;
- You have knowledge of, and ability to apply, an understanding of First Nations cultural principles and protocols;
- You have knowledge and the application of concepts, principles, and theories of trans-cultural nursing, including knowledge of traditional, homeopathic or other healing practices used in the community;
- You have knowledge of First Nations cultures and backgrounds, and the understanding of how culture impacts on communication patterns, and attitudes and approaches to health issues.
- You have an understanding of rural and remote communities and their inherent challenges and barriers
- You have knowledge of nursing which includes the nursing process, conceptual frameworks of nursing, theories and principles of nursing practice.
- You have demonstrated understanding and integration of Trauma Informed Practice to care.

The First Nations-led Primary Health Care Initiative (FNPCI) aims to improve access to primary health care services for First Nations people across BC in a way that is culturally safe and closer to home.
