This posting is to establish an eligibility list for future permanent and/or temporary vacancies within the Province of British Columbia. These positions may be located in any of the following five (5) regional locations of: Vancouver Island (Victoria); Interior (Kelowna or Kamloops); Vancouver (Vancouver); Fraser (Burnaby or New Westminster); North (Prince George or Fort St John – currently this position is done virtually from Victoria).

The successful applicant will be located in one of the regional locations and will be required to travel within the region.

The Primary Care Division (PCD) is responsible for setting provincial direction to support a high functioning primary health-care system that meets the needs of all British Columbians. The Planning and Implementation Oversight Branch supports the reforms that are built around team-based care provided through a mix of full-service family practices, Urgent and Primary Care Centres (UPCC), Community Health Centres and First Nations-led Primary Care Centers linked together with one another and with other primary and community care services as part of local Primary Care Networks.

The Regional Manager, Primary Care Planning, and Implementation Oversight, is responsible for building relationships with primary care partners and guiding partners in planning and implement primary care networks in the Region in which they are located.

Qualifications for this role include:

- Bachelor's Degree or higher in a relevant discipline such as Business Administration, Health Administration, Social Services or Public Administration. An equivalent combination of education, training, and experience may be considered.
- Three (3) years or more of demonstrated experience in each of the following areas:
 - community development,
 - project management, and/or
 - business case development.
- Experience with Patient and Public Engagement
- Experience in establishing relationships with multiple external stakeholders/partners
- Experience establishing collaborative relationships and leading change
- Experience negotiating agreements and working collaboratively in partnership arrangements
- Experience in a supervisory/management role including resolving complex staff and/or client issues
