HealthLinkBC (HLBC) provides 24/7 access to non-emergency health information and advice in British Columbia. Information and advice are available by telephone, website, mobile app, and print resources, including the BC Health Guide Handbook. HealthLinkBC brings together recognized health information services, including nursing, pharmacist, dietitian, and physical activity, and online and by-phone navigation services to help the citizens of BC and the Yukon find health resources and facilities.

The Manager, Nursing Services (NS) applies an understanding of HLBC's operations and comprehensive knowledge of both Public Service Association (PSA) and Provincial Health Services Authority policies and collective and component agreements to manage the provision of services within the position's area of responsibility. This position is responsible for 24/7 staff rotation planning and scheduling aligning to budget, attendance wellness and management, disability case management, medical accommodations and workplace health and safety. This position is also responsible for directing the NS support teams and implementing several HLBC initiatives and programs designed to support the management team at HLBC.

Qualifications for this role include:

- Bachelor's degree in Nursing, Health Sciences, or Business Administration; or an equivalent combination of education and *related experience.

*Related experience must include each of the following:

- Minimum of 3 years experience in a progressive leadership role in multidisciplinary service delivery operations.
- Experience working collaboratively with multiple stakeholder groups and leading organizational change in a unionized environment.
- Experience with strategic and operational planning initiatives.
