The Maples Adolescent Centre is a program of Provincial Services Division of the Ministry of Children and Family Development. The Maples is a designated provincial mental health facility providing on-site, community, outreach and ancillary services to collaboratively support youth, families and communities. The Maples target population consists of youth in British Columbia with significant psychiatric and behavioural difficulties, ages 12 to 17, as well as youth found Not Criminally Responsible by Reason of a Mental Disorder (NCRMD) or unfit to stand trial.

Under the direction of a Shift Supervisor, the Nurse acts as a member of the interdisciplinary team and provides direct comprehensive nursing care to clients. Positions at this level work rotating shift hours as Maples is a 24/7 facility.
