This is a full-time temporary opportunity to February 3, 2025, that may be extended or may become permanent. Board and lodging and relocation expenses do not apply.

Flexible work options are available; this position may be able to work up to one (1) day at home per week subject to an approved telework agreement.

Youth Forensic Psychiatric Services (YFPS) is mandated to provide inpatient and outpatient Court-ordered and Court-related assessment and treatment services to young persons pursuant to the Youth Criminal Justice Act as well as other relevant federal and provincial statutes.

Services are provided through outpatient clinics and contracted service providers located throughout the province. An inpatient assessment unit (IAU), located in Burnaby provides mental health services to BYCS.

Assessment and treatment services for youth may include specialised treatment services for: youth who may have committed violent or sexual offences; youth who have offended and are experiencing mental health, behavioural, drug and/or alcohol addictions problems; and youth in custody facilities who are in need of mental health services.

Qualifications for this role include:

- Registered as a Registered Nurse or Registered Psychiatric Nurse with the BC College of Nurses and Midwives (BCCNM).
- A Diploma in Psychiatric Nursing; or an Advanced Diploma in Psychiatric Nursing; or a Baccalaureate Degree in Nursing.
 - **NOTE:** If your degree was obtained outside of Canada, you need to confirm it has been assessed for equivalency through the International Credential Evaluation Services ([ICES](#)). You must provide a basic report by the closing date of this posting to be considered.
- Experience in Community Psychiatric Nursing with youth and involuntary clients.
- Minimum of three (3) years of experience in psychiatric nursing.
- Must possess and maintain a valid class 5 BC Driver's license with no restriction or equivalent (i.e. from another Canadian Province).
