The successful applicant will provide leadership, direction and specialized advice in all phases of the development and administration of large, complex, and sensitive legislative and regulatory changes in response to initiatives and priorities of the ministry and government.

Qualifications for this role include:

- A university degree in business administration, public administration, law, or related field or equivalent and three (3) years of related experience, OR an equivalent combination of education and related experience may be considered.

Related experience must include:

- Experience in planning, developing and/or implementing significant policy, regulatory, or legislative changes.
- Experience at a senior level organizing and managing projects of large scale and complexity and/or concurrent diverse projects that have multiple project delivery components, competing priorities and rigid deadlines, while following project management techniques.
- Experience influencing and collaborating productively with partners and stakeholders to initiate fundamental and substantive change to existing policies, programs or legislation and facilitate introduction and implementation of new programs or legislation.
- Experience leading organizational change associated with implementation of policy, regulatory or legislative changes.
- Experience building teams, supervising and developing staff, and motivating team members to achieve results in the development and implementation of complex projects.
