The Hospital and Provincial Health Services Division (HPS) leads service transformation across the health sector. The successful applicant will analyze and develop policy, manage projects and provide advice and recommendations related to the Patient Care Quality program.

Qualifications for this role include:

- Degree in public administration, health sciences, social sciences or a related field and a minimum of two (2) years progressive and related experience* (if master's degree is obtained, then a minimum of one (1) year of progressive and related experience* is required) OR
- Diploma in public administration, health sciences, social sciences or a related field and a minimum of four (4) years progressive and related experience* OR
- No degree and a minimum of six (6) years progressive and related experience. *

***Progressive and related experience must include:**

- Researching policy issues and conducting policy analyses.
- Consulting and/or working in partnership with impacted parties or organizations.
- Managing projects and/or project components.
- Evaluating programs and/or services.

Preference may be given to applicants with the following:

- Applicants who identify as Indigenous (First Nations, Métis or Inuit).
- Experience developing policy and/or legislation.
- Experience providing advice and recommendations on policy, program, or service issues in the health care or social policy sector.
